Dear Candidate for Prince George's County Executive:

The IHHAAC Board of Directors invites you for an interview and discussion of your views on issues of importance to Prince George's County residents. The discussion will be similar to what you would experience if you were meeting with the Editorial Board of a newspaper. The panel will be composed of about fourteen civic leaders and activists from associations located throughout Councilmanic Districts 8 & 9.

Your interview will be scheduled at a mutually convenient time, probably a weekday evening beginning at 7:00 PM. You will have two to three hours to discuss your candidacy. Once all County Executive candidates who choose to participate have been interviewed, the Panel will meet to discuss the qualifications and views of each candidate. If consensus is achieved, the Panel will endorse a candidate.

Each interview will be private; no other candidates, nor their representatives, will be in the room. Candidates are expected to arrive alone without staff or handlers. If a driver is required, s/he may wait in the Green Room until the interview is over. They may not be present nor participate in the discussion.

In preparation for this event, attached you will find a list of fifteen questions. Please answer them in writing and submit them electronically to the Program Coordinator in .doc format (Microsoft Word 97-2003) no later than seven (7) days prior to your scheduled interview. He will forward them to the members of the Panel. Your answers will serve as a point of departure for discussion with the civic leaders. At a later date, responses to the questionnaire may be posted on the IHHAAC website and distributed electronically to our members and friends as a public service to voters.

Your interview will take place in the IHHAAC Board Room at 415 River Wood Drive, Fort Washington, MD 20744. Candidates wishing to participate are requested to discuss scheduling with IHHAAC Vice President and Program Coordinator Bill Cavitt at whcavitt@comcast.net and/or call 301-839-4764.
